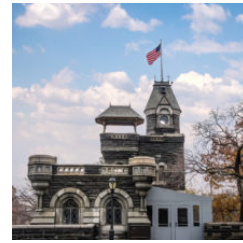

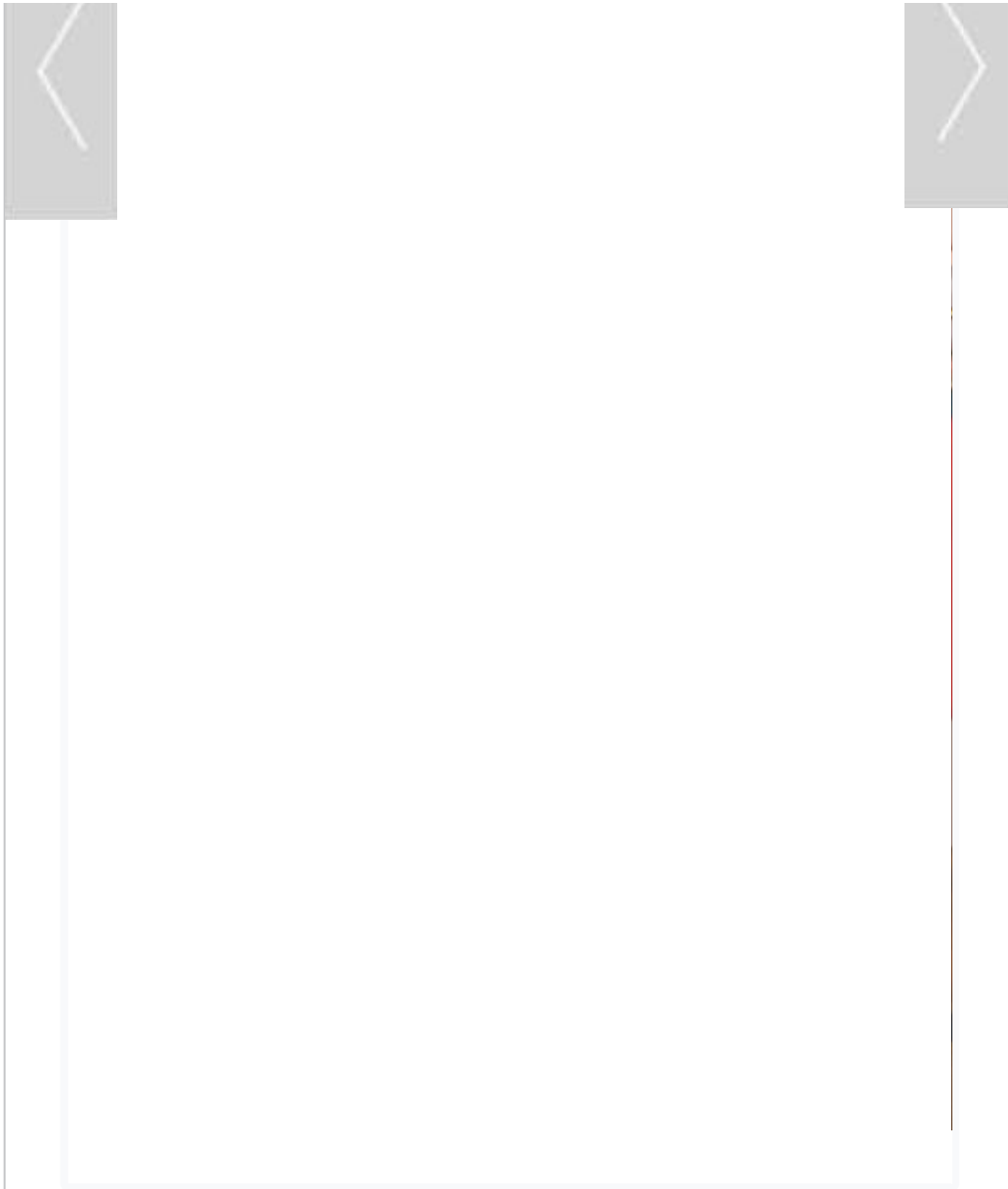
Darcy Miller Celebrates Everything with Drew Barrymore
